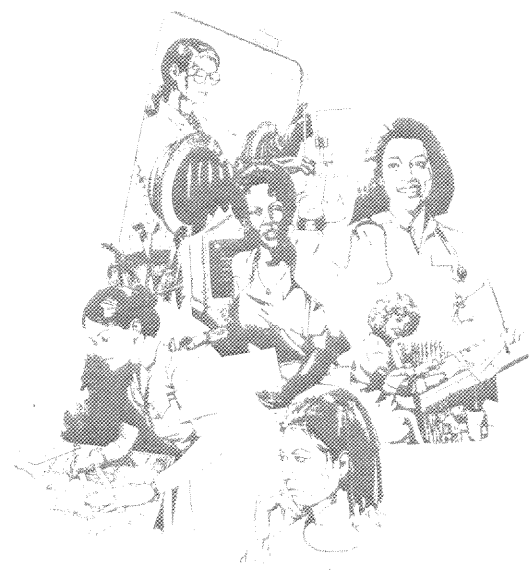
**DIRECTIONS TO LOYOLA MARYMOUNT UNIVERSITY**
